Four elementary students named top spellers in county

Winning students from Wilson School, Marguerite Hahn Elementary School, Luther Burbank School and West Side School

Twenty students competed in the 2016 Sonoma County Elementary Spelling Competition held on Monday, March 7, at the Sonoma County Office of Education (SCOE). This annual event brings the county's best fourth, fifth, and sixth grade spellers together in a competition designed to promote and acknowledge exemplary student achievement. These students previously won school and regional spelling competitions, which made them eligible to compete for the title of county spelling champion.

Caleb Poole, a sixth-grader from Wilson School in Petaluma, won first in the competition. He broke the tie in the eighth-round by spelling "scuttlebutt" correctly, then spelling "claustrophobia" to win the event.

Second place went to fifth-grader Kasey Adamski, who attends Marguerite Hahn

Elementary School in Rohnert Park. Sixth-grader Yuridiana Espinosa, from Luther Burbank

School in Santa Rosa, took third place and Jake Gordon, a sixth-grader from West Side School in

Healdsburg, earned the fourth-place award.

All spellers received a certificate of accomplishment, participation ribbon, and a souvenir. The four top-place spellers received trophies to mark their achievement. First and second place winners are eligible to advance to the 2016 California State Elementary Spelling Championship, which will be held at the San Joaquin County Office of Education in the Wentworth Education Center, 2707 Transworld Drive in Stockton on Saturday, April 23.
